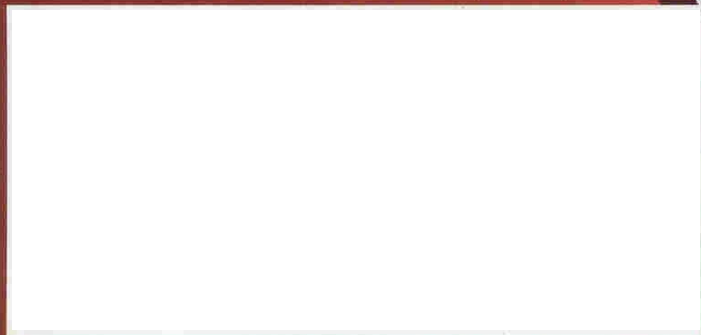

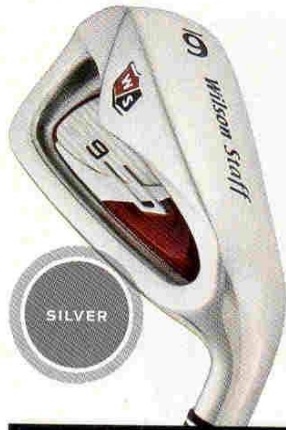

TECH TALK
After Wilson's research revealed that more than 80 percent of iron strikes are from the center to the toe area, the company turned its focus to helping players with mis-hits on the toe by increasing the hosel length, using wide-tip shaft technology and moving weight to the toe. A wider sole and lower blade height than its predecessor help increase MOI as well.
